Cost estimate of expenses:

Your total expenses minus your total projected revenue should equal zero. If your projected revenue and total expenses are not equal, go back into Budget Worksheets parts 1 and 2 to increase or decrease these numbers until they equal zero. Realize this is a basic estimate of your needs. From this range, you can get an approved budget for distribution to your Team Captains.
