

Playground Re-Opening Grant

Welcome to the Re-opening Playground Grant Application

The Playground Re-opening Grants are designed to help communities impacted by Hurricanes Harvey and Irma to bring their playgrounds back to a state where they are fully functional and safe for the kids in the community. Many playgrounds have been closed due to unsafe conditions on the playground in the wake of the storms.

The playground Re-opening Grants intend to accelerate recovery efforts for the hurricane-impacted communities and restore play for kids as quickly as possible. Each Playground Re-opening Grant will provide up to \$4,500 for labor and material costs associated with re-opening the playground. The Playground Re-Opening Grant will also extend KaBOOM! discounts for engineered wood fiber to the applicant, reducing the total expense for replacing the safety surfacing. Most applicants will find it helpful to first have the playground inspected by a Certified Playground Safety Inspector or their playground distributor who can provide a complete safety inspection and an estimate of the cost required to restore the playground. This grant may not cover all of the costs associated with re-opening the playground, so applicants should be prepared to seek funds from other sources (insurance, fundraising, donations, etc). Organizations receiving funds under this grant program must have their playground re-opened no later than six months after receiving the grant or by August 31, whichever comes first.

Before applying, make sure to have all of the information needed to complete the application. You will not be able to save your application and come back later. Click <u>here</u> for all of the questions.

There will be ten (10) Playground Re-opening Grants awarded in 2017-2018 on a rolling basis.

Applicant Criteria

- Be a registered 501(c)3 child-serving non-profit or a municipality.
- Have a professionally installed playground which was damaged during Hurricane Harvey or Hurricane

 Irma
- Serve a low-income population.
- Be able to obtain a cost estimate for playground rehab from a professional qualified vendor such as an equipment manufacturer.
- Commit to fundraising or obtaining any funds over the \$4,500 grant amount that will be required to implement playground rehab.
- Be able to fully complete the project and re-open the playground by August 30, 2018 or six months from receiving the grant, whichever comes first.
