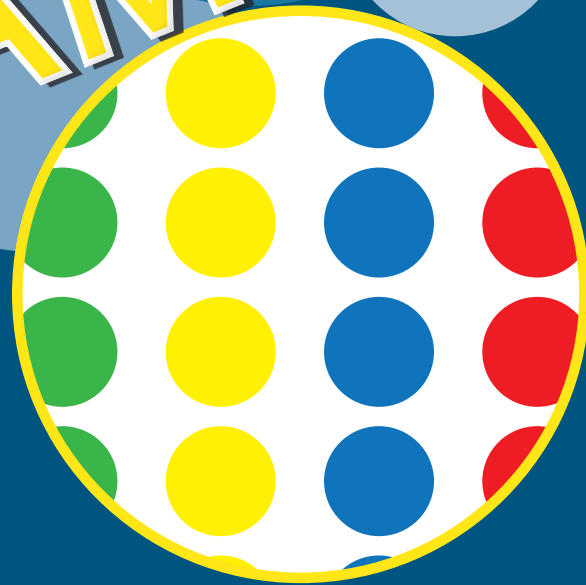

Materials:

you choose: chalk, giant dice

Description:
Your Play Day is a great time to break out some old favorites and bring them outside, like Twister, Chess, or Monopoly. Play them on a large scale and instead of having a game piece, each player is a game piece!

Steps:
First, recreate the game board outside. If you have an asphalt area, you may want to use chalk. If you have a game like Twister, you can simply attach multiple boards together.

If you're playing a board game with "teams" like chess or checkers, a set of matching shirts will help. If you're playing a game where each individual plays on their own, like Monopoly, a bunch of different colored hats can add to the fun!

Continue to follow the rules of whichever game you are playing, until one person or team wins.
