

# SIMON SAYS



## INSTRUCTIONS:

**Number of Participants:**  
3+ people

**Materials:**  
None!

**Description:**

Simon Says is a game of imitation that can be played with kids of all ages, and always results in peals of laughter.

**Steps:**

Pick one person to be "Simon." Simon's job is to tell the rest of the players what they should do.

Players must only obey commands that begin with the words "Simon says." So if Simon says, "Simon says touch your nose," then players must touch their nose. But, if Simon says "Jump!" (without the "Simon says"), then the players shouldn't jump.

Standing in front of the group, Simon starts to give instructions, trying to trick the players into following commands when they shouldn't.

Players that get tricked into following commands that don't start with "Simon says" are out for the round.

The last person left after all others are out is the next Simon.
