

SNAIL



INSTRUCTIONS:

Number of Participants:
2-6 people

Materials:
Chalk, pebble

Description:
Snail is a fun variation of hopscotch.

Steps:
Draw a large spiral on the ground using chalk.

Split the spiral into squares so the children can hop from one to the next. There can be as many squares as you like! It's also fun to add antennae and legs to make it look more like a snail.

Each player should take a pebble and toss it onto the snail to mark the squares that players will have to skip over.

Then each player takes turns hopping through the squares toward the center of the spiral, skipping over any squares that have a pebble in them.

If a person steps on a line, or hops onto a square that had a pebble, the person's turn ends or they lose that game.
